## Competition Format and Rules

Formato y reglas de la competencia / Format et règles de compétition

### Youth Olympic Competition Format

The Karate competition at the Summer Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 consists of three weight categories for both men and women.

#### Weight Categories

Women's Kumite	Men's Kumite
-53kg	-61kg
-59kg	-68kg
+59kg	+68kg

#### Elimination round:

The elimination round consists of two pools (A and B) of four contestants. All contestants compete against each other within each pool (a total of six bouts in each pool). The contestants are ranked according to the results achieved in their pool (number of points and scores). A contestant winning a bout will be awarded two points. The contestants will be awarded one point each in case of a tied bout. The top two contestants from each pool qualify to the semifinals.

#### Semifinals and Finals:

The winner of pool A competes against the second ranked contestant from pool B, and the winner of pool B competes against the second ranked contestant from pool A. The Semifinal winners compete for the gold and silver medals. The Semifinal losers are both awarded bronze medals.

#### Weigh-in

The weigh-in for the competition will be held at the venue under the supervision of two officials appointed by the WKF. The official weigh-in for each weight category will take place at the venue in the morning of the day before the first competition day.

#### Differences between the WKF World Juniors, Cadet and U21 Championships and the Summer Youth Olympic Games

There are fewer weight categories in the Youth Olympic Games than at the WKF World Junior Championships (three instead of five), and some weight categories have been merged for the Youth Olympic Games.

#### Changes since the Summer Youth Olympic Games Nanjing 2014

Karate is on the programme for the first time in Buenos Aires 2018.

### Sport Rules and Procedures

#### Competition Method

The competition area will be a square mat, with sides of eight metres (measured from the outside) with an additional one metre on all sides as a safety area. There will also be a clear safety area of two metres on each side of the mat.

The contestants, AKA (red) and AO (blue), compete against each other using punching and kicking techniques performed on permitted parts of the body.

#### Bout

One referee, four judges and a match supervisor manage the bout. The duration of the bouts will be two minutes (actual time) for men and for women.

#### Scoring Format

- Points:

Contestants receive points according to correctly executed techniques (controlled punches, strikes and kicks). The valid points in Kumite are as follows:

- One ("Yuko") point for a straight punch or strikes delivered to the body and/or face.
- Two ("Waza-Ari") points for a middle kick delivered to the body.
- Three ("Ippon") points for a high kick delivered to the head, or for a punch delivered on an opponent who has been taken to the ground after a sweep or takedown.



- Warnings and penalties:
  - Warnings are classified in two categories; Category one for contact fouls, and category two for other fouls.
  - Warnings have three levels, and must be increased for repeated infractions within the category.
  - The maximum number of warnings allowable within a category is three, after which any further infraction results in disqualification. For serious infractions disqualification may be imposed directly without previous warning.
  - Disqualifications have two levels: Hansoku - disqualification from the bout, and Shikkaku - disqualification from the entire tournament.
- Result:
  - The winner is the contestant that has the highest number of points at full time, or who gains eight points lead before full time.
  - If the score is equal at full time, the winner is the contestant that remains with the "first unopposed score advantage" (Senshu).
  - In case of equal score without Senshu during the Elimination Round (Hikiwake), the tie remains.
  - In case of equal score during semifinals and finals and no unopposed first score (Senshu), the winner is determined by majority vote (Hantei) of the four judges and the referee.
- Bout outcome
  - Won by Points
  - Won by Senshu
  - Won by Hantei
  - Won by Kiken
  - Won by Shikkaku
  - Won by Hansoku
  - Hikiwake (Elimination Round only)

### **Tie Break Rules**

Elimination Round classification:

If there is a tie between two or more contestants, the criteria below will apply in the following order, until the tie is broken:

1. Winner(s) of the bout(s) between the two (or more) tied competitors
2. Higher number of scores obtained in favour of each competitor in all bouts
3. Lower number of scores against each competitor in all bouts
4. Higher number of Ippon in favour of each competitor in all bouts
5. Lower number of Ippon against each competitor in all bouts
6. Higher number of Waza-Ari in favour of each competitor in all bouts
7. Lower number of Waza-Ari against each competitor in all bouts
8. Higher number of Yuko in favour of each competitor in all bouts
9. Lower number of Yuko against each competitor in all bouts
10. The competitor with the highest position in the Olympic Standings

If the tie remains unbroken an additional bout will be held.

Semifinals and Finals:

If the score is tied after full time, when one contestant has obtained "first unopposed score advantage" (Senshu), that contestant will be declared the winner.

If the score is tied after full time and no score has been obtained by either competitor; or if the score is equal, but neither competitor has obtained "first unopposed score advantage" (Senshu); the tie will be broken by majority vote of the four judges and the referee.

### **Disqualification Rules**

There are two types of disqualification in Karate:

- At the Weigh-in, for a no show or medical decision: Kiken. In case of no show for a bout, the contestant will lose that bout, but may continue the competition, when possible.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct: Shikkaku. In this case, the contestant will be disqualified from the entire competition.

### **Protests/Appeals**

Coaches on the field of play have the right to call for one video review (VR) per competition phase (Elimination Round, Semifinals and Finals). If the Video Review Supervisor (VRS) decides in favour of the coach making the request, the coach retains his original right to one video review (VR).
